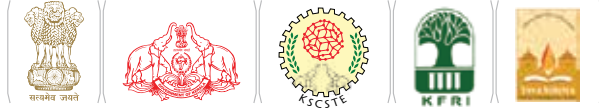

The Kerala Science Congress (KSC) is an event initiated by the erstwhile Science, Technology & Environment Committee (STEC) way back in 1989, which has become an annual event thereafter. KSC over the years has been providing a platform for young researchers, scientists, academicians, technologists and all interested in Science & Technology from the State and elsewhere to exchange knowledge and share their research findings for the S & T development of the State. The event consists of technical sessions involving lectures by eminent scientists, research presentation by young researchers, memorial lectures, post-graduate student interactive session and the Children's science congress. Young researchers are honored with the Chief Minister's Gold medal and 'Kerala State Young Scientist Award' during the session. Awards also will be given to the best Oral and Poster presentations of original research findings by the delegates in the different subject areas of the Congress. The 32nd edition of the Kerala Science Congress will be organized jointly by KSCSTE & KFRI at Yuvakshetra Institute of Management Studies, Mundoor, Palakkad.

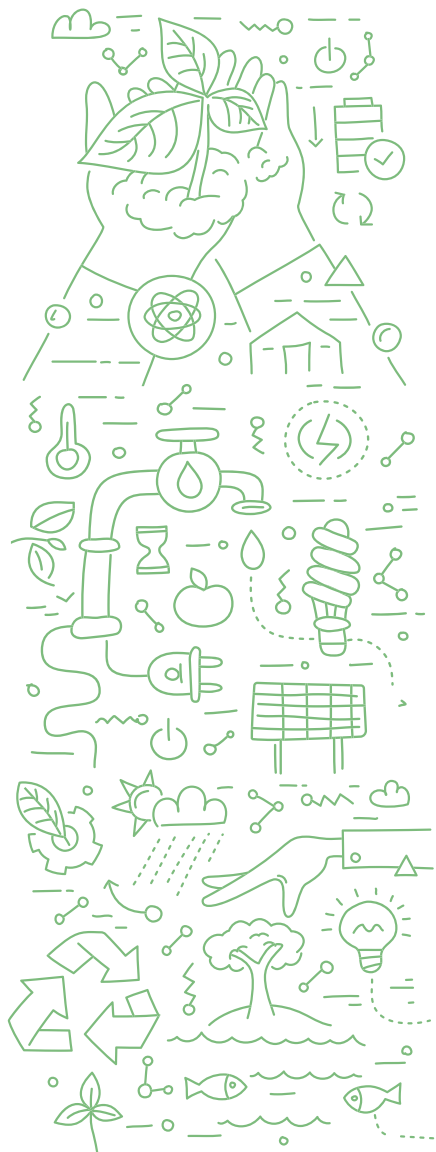

PG Students Interaction: A dedicated session for face-to-face interaction of post graduate student with eminent scientists shall be a star event of the KSC. The event is organized to expose them to the range of opportunities and career prospects in different areas of S&T including updation of contemporary development. Participation in the interactive sessions will be based on nomination from academic institutions in the State.

Children's Science Congress: Students who have been selected for National Children's Science Congress in the year 2019 are invited for presenting their projects during the session. Students of classes 7 to 12 from the schools of Palakkad District are invited as delegates in this session.

National Science Exhibition: The science exhibition serves as a platform for inspiring the students and researchers as well as for creating scientific awareness among the common people at large. The National Science Exhibition with the participation of major R&D organizations, S&T institutions and industry will be held during 25-27 January 2020 at Yuvakshetra Institute of Management Studies, Palakkad.

Oral and Poster Presentation Awards: Awards will be given to the delegates in four categories: viz. Best Student and Scientist Oral Presentation and Poster Presentation Awards.

Proceedings of the Congress: Abstracts of all accepted papers will be included in the proceedings. The proceedings will be released at the Science Congress venue. The soft copy of the proceedings can be downloaded from KSC website once it is published.

Language: Official language of Kerala Science Congress will be English. All paper submissions should be in English. However, contributors are free to present their paper in English or Malayalam in the subject area
